Tangerine Trees

Formed in 2022, Tangerine Trees consists of four life-long musicians led by Roger Leonhardt (vocals/guitar), Scott Moon (drums/vocals), Jimmy Ennis (bass/vocals) and John White (guitar). They may not look like the Beatles or have the cool mop-tops, but they pride themselves in playing Beatles songs as close to the original as they can, both musically and vocally. The WannaBeatles Based out of Nashville, TN and made up of Dennis Scott, Bryan Cumming, Nathan Burbank, and David Toledo, The WannaBeatles like to say that they go “where no Beatles band has gone before.” Inspired by the stories of fellow Beatles fans, they produced Fab Fan Memories – The Beatles Bond. The album, narrated by Louise Harrison (George’s big sister) was Grammy-nominated for Best Spoken Word Album. The band uses their multi-instrumental skills to re-create all eras of the Beatles song catalogue. “We literally tie ourselves into pretzels to reproduce songs that The Beatles themselves never performed live,” they said. thewannabeatles.com

Wonderwall The Tribute In 2003, during International Beatle Week in Liverpool England, Wonderwall The Tribute backed Jackie Lomax (original Apple Records artist in 1968), and they’ve been headlining clubs, theaters, and Beatles festivals ever since. Doug Dennis (bass), Cameron Owen (guitar), plus original members, Stan Bullock (drums), and Chuck Martin (guitar, keyboards) all contribute vocally, and have built a solid reputation as a premier musical tribute to The Beatles. facebook.com.beatlesliveson


